The deadline for submission is August 31, 2016.

This year's event will focus on issues related to capital flows and optimal policy management, international considerations of monetary and macroprudential policies, exchange rates, central banks' balance sheets, financial frictions and financial stability.

The RIDGE December Forum aims to favor the spread of high quality research in economics by bringing together top researchers working on the frontier of knowledge with local and regional researchers and policymakers.

Full papers, written in English, may be submitted for consideration for the meeting. The cover page should include: the title of the paper, institutional affiliation (including address, phone number and email of each author) as well as an abstract with the appropriate JEL classification.

Each author can submit and present at most one paper, although can be co-author of other submitted papers
