Call for papers for the Workshop on Environmental Economics

The Research Institute for Development, Growth and Economics (RIDGE) is pleased to announce a call for papers for the Workshop on Environmental Economics to be held in Montevideo, Uruguay, on 7 December 2016. The deadline for submission is October 1, 2016 (12 AM ET).

The accepted contributions for this Workshop are expected to be relevant for understanding the most important challenges of environmental, climate change and natural resources policies in Latin America and Caribbean countries. This allows for papers addressing issues in other regions when those issues are deemed relevant to the Latin American context. Studies of specific Latin American countries, as well as comparative institutional analyses are also welcome.

Both theoretical and empirical contributions are welcome. There will be a dedicated discussion for each paper, as well as open floor discussion.

The workshop will take place within the framework of the 2016 RIDGE December Forum along with the following workshops:

Full papers, written in English, must be submitted for consideration for the workshop. The cover page should include: the title of the paper, institutional affiliation, including address, phone and email of each author and an abstract with the appropriate JEL classification.

Each author can submit and present at most one paper per workshop (submission of papers to other workshops is possible).
