Call for papers for the Workshop on International Macro

The Research Institute for Development, Growth and Economics (RIDGE) and the Banco Central del Uruguay are pleased to announce the call for papers for the Workshop on International Macro to be held in Montevideo, Uruguay, on 5-6 December 2017.

The deadline for submission is September 1, 2017.

This year's event will focus on issues related to capital flows and optimal policy management, international considerations of monetary and macroprudential policies, exchange rates, central banks' balance sheets, fiscal rules and cyclical patterns of fiscal policy, financial frictions and financial stability.

The 2017 workshop will take place within the framework of the 2017 RIDGE December Forum along with the following workshops:

- Financial Stability, December 7-8 (Montevideo, Uruguay)
- Growth and Development in Macroeconomics, December 18-19 (Montevideo, Uruguay)

The RIDGE December Forum aims to favor the spread of high quality research in economics by bringing together top researchers working on the frontier of knowledge with local and regional researchers and policymakers. Participants to this workshop are welcome to attend the other workshops.

Paper Submission

Full papers, written in English, may be submitted for consideration for the meeting. The cover page should include: the title of the paper, institutional affiliation (including address, phone number and email of each author) as well as an abstract with the appropriate JEL classification.

Each author can submit and present at most one paper, although can be co-author of other submitted papers
