### Description

The Summer School will take place in Montevideo on August 1-3 2018. Students are expected to participate in the Inflation Expectations workshop (Aug 3) and the “Jornadas de Economía del Banco Central del Uruguay” (Aug 1-2 <http://www.bcu.gub.uy/Comunicaciones/Paginas/JAE-2018.aspx>)

The RIDGE Summer School aims to give young Latin American economists the opportunity to attend lectures by top scholars and to be part of the debate about the frontier of knowledge in economics. Lecturers give an overview of the main open issues on topics related to the Forum.

The RIDGE Forum aims to favor the spread of high quality research in economics and promotes the development of new views on economic thinking from the perspective of developing countries. It brings together top researchers working on the frontier of knowledge with researchers working in Latin America and Latin American policy makers.

The Summer School targets outstanding graduate economists. In this opportunity, priority will be given to Uruguayan students enrolled in Graduate programs in economics.
