The deadline for submission is October 1, 2019 (12 AM ET).

We accept contributions relevant for understanding the most important environmental policy challenges in Latin America and the Caribbean (LAC). These include studies of specific LAC countries, as well as comparative institutional analyses.

Papers addressing issues from other regions deemed relevant to LAC are also welcome.

Both theoretical and empirical contributions are welcome. There will be a dedicated discussant for each paper, as well as open floor discussion.

The workshop will take place within the framework of the 2019 RIDGE December Forum along with the following workshops:

Submission should be full papers, written in English. The cover page should include the title of the paper, institutional affiliation, address, phone number and email of each author, an abstract with the appropriate JEL classification.

Each author can submit and present at most one paper per workshop (submission of papers to other workshops is possible).
